PURPOSE:

To define the company's policy for reducing our impact on the environment.

SCOPE:

Hazardous Wastes: Recyclable wastes: paper, cardboard, plastic, bottles, cans and scrap wire or cable.
Composting food items.

POLICY:

It is the policy of The Data Cable Company Incorporated to:

1. Design our manufacturing and administrative processes to be as lean as possible and reduce waste.
2. Recycle wastes generated by manufacturing, administration and human consumption.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

It is the responsibility of all Data Cable employees to:

3. Recycle food items, napkins and paper plates into green bins.

It is the responsibility of all Data Cable Managers and Team Leaders to:

1. Develop initiatives in their area to reduce the amount of wastes generated.
2. Provide adequate, easily access containers for their recyclable wastes.
3. Ensure personnel are sorting recyclables as required.

1. Semi-annual disposal of Hazardous waste (Ref.: HS-260 Hazardous Substance Inventory) at the town of Orangeville hazardous waste site.
